



## DERBY MIDLAND STATION ENTRANCE CANOPY

GGP Consult were commissioned by East Midlands Trains to create a new entrance canopy to the main entrance of Derby Midlands Station.

The works formed an element of the Station Gateway Scheme which was part of the wider project The Derby Cityscape masterplan. The full scheme entailed a £2 billion regeneration of Derby City Centre.

The Station Gateway scheme aimed to improve the experience of people arriving in the city by train and create a better link between the train station and the city centre.

A new entrance canopy of stainless steel and glass was designed to provide a modern canopy to the main entrance of Derby station. The new canopy compliments the Derby station transport interchange project. The stainless steel frame created some unique engineering challenges compared to a conventional steel frame and the new canopy was required to interface seamlessly with the existing building.

GGP Consult were responsible for the architectural and structural engineering design of the canopy as well as submitting a Landlords Consent application to Network Rail for approval of the scheme.
