

## CRANESHAUGH LAND SLIP, HEXHAM

CLIENT – Network Rail

GGP Consult and AMCO were called to a Network Rail emergency when an embankment failed in Craneshaugh, Hexham.

During a period of continuous heavy rain a land slip had occurred on an embankment adjacent to a busy line.

A site survey and investigation report were undertaken immediately and a solution was proposed within hours of the initial failure.

Teams were mobilised to remove the saturated material and replace with large boulder stone infill to restore the slope profile with a stone fill surface dressing.

Upon completion of the work further recommendations were made for the maintenance and improvement of the embankment.
